- 2 Hour private cruise with Amelia River Cruises. This cruise offers narrated historic and wildlife sightseeing of Amelia and Cumberland Island.
- Tour of the Amelia Island Museum which is the first spoken history museum in the state of Florida.
- Private dinner at Slidders Restaurant located on the ocean several miles from the hotel. Beautiful views of the ocean can be seen from the private room.
