TOURS/PLACES TO GO

ICON PARK, (Part of the International Drive Entertainment District)

The Wheel at Icon Park is called the Orlando Eye. This stunning 400 ft. tall observation wheel gives you a view of Orlando like no other.

Aquatic Exploration at Sea Life Orlando Aquarium boasts a 360-degree underwater tunnel. This state-of-the-art attraction invites you to see aquatic life from the Atlantic, Pacific, and Indian oceans.

Madame Tussauds Wax Museum featuring the Justice League heroes. The world of celebrity fun awaits.

Ripley's Believe It or Not Museum with kitschy oddities on display.

Gatorland Wildlife Park, the alligator capital of the world. Gatorland is a 110-acre theme park and wildlife preserve with thousands of alligators & crocodiles to see, an aviary, breeding marsh with observation tower, nature walk and reptilian shows.

Disney Springs near our hotel offers a variety of unique shops, one-of-a-kind restaurants, and lively entertainment. Disney Springs was inspired by Florida's charming waterfront towns, historic architecture,
